

# SAFETY INFORMATION SHEET

## **LAUNDRY & DYEING**

#### WHAT THIS SHEET APPLIES TO

Dyeing, washing and drying fabric and/ or clothing in the Laundry & Dye Room.

#### **RISKS INCLUDE**

Contact with dye (powdered and liquid). Contact with bleach/detergent.

#### **GUIDELINES, RULES, & PROCEDURES**

- All persons working in the laundry/dye area must have the approval of the Department of Theater & Dance Costume Shop Manager.
- 2. Know the location of the nearest first-aid kit and fire alarm pull boxes.
- 3. Know the location of the nearest fire extinguisher and how to use it.

#### WHEN DYEING FABRIC:

- 4. Look at MSDS sheets for the product before using.
- 5. Wear rubber gloves to protect your skin.
- Wear protective clothing (lab coat).

- 7. Wear goggles if you use caustic dyes or corrosive chemicals.
- 8. Wear dust mask if using large amounts of powdered dye.
- 9. Unplug hotplate after using.

#### WHEN USING THE WASHING MACHINE:

- 10. Turn on the water supply to use.
- 11. Turn OFF the water supply when done.
- 12. Remain on the Bottom floor while in use.

#### WHEN USING THE DRYER:

- 13. Remove the lint from the screen when done.
- 14. Remain on the Bottom floor while in use.
