

MESABI COMMUNITY COLLEGE

The College of Saint Benedict (CSB) and Saint John's University (SJU) welcome Mesabi Community College transfer students. All courses from an official transcript will be evaluated to determine which of our Core Curriculum requirements they will fulfill.

Transferable courses are defined as *courses that are similar to a course offered at CSB/SJU, in which a grade of "C" or better was received, and that have a course number 1000 or above*. Note: A minimum of three semester credits is required to complete a CSB/SJU core curriculum requirement, with the exception of fine arts.

At least 45 of the 124 semester credits required for a degree must be earned from CSB/SJU. At least half of the credits required for the major, excluding supporting courses, must be earned from CSB/SJU.

Finally, it should be noted that this guide is designed as one tool to aid in your course selections for transferring to CSB/SJU. Listed below each of the CSB/SJU Core Curriculum requirements (bolded) are the **Mesabi Community College** courses that fulfill that specific requirement.

FIRST YEAR SYMPOSIUM

Transfer credits need to be discussed with Academic Advising.

HUMANITIES

A course from two different disciplines with a minimum of three semester credits per course.

ENGL: 1548, 1558, 1576, 1577, 2535, 2536, 2537, 2538

HIST: 1555, 1556, 1565, 1566

PHIL: 1551, 1575

MATH (one course)

MATH: 1511 and 1512 together or 1545, 1556, 1561, 1562, 2563, 2564

(Math 1521 or 1547 will fulfill proficiency requirement but not the math course requirement)

NATURAL SCIENCES

A course from two different science disciplines with a minimum of three semester credits—all courses must have labs.

BIOL: 1535, 1545, 1546, 1551, 1552, 2535, 2551, 2552

CHEM: 1511, 1512, 1522, 1523, 2512, 2513

GEOL: 1557

PHYS: 1561, 1562, 1565 w/1566, 1571 w/1581, 1572 w/1582

SOCIAL SCIENCES

A minimum of three semester credits is necessary to fulfill requirement.

ANTH: 1525, 1535
ECON: 1555, 1556, 1557
GEOG: 1556
POLS: 1556, 1557, 1559
PSYC: 2551, 2556, 2565, 2567
SOC: 1452, 1555, 1557, 1559, 1565

FINE ARTS

A minimum of four semester credits is necessary to fulfill the requirement.

ART: All courses
ENGL: 1559
MUSC: All courses
THTR: All courses

FOREIGN LANGUAGES

A student will have fulfilled the foreign language requirement if they have documented proficiency through the intermediate level or has taken courses through the intermediate level.

ADDITIONAL COURSES ACCEPTED FOR ELECTIVE CREDIT
