

NORMANDALE COMMUNITY COLLEGE

The College of Saint Benedict (CSB) and Saint John's University (SJU) welcome Normandale Community College transfer students. All courses from an official transcript will be evaluated to determine which of our Core Curriculum requirements they will fulfill.

Transferable courses are defined as *courses that are similar to a course offered at CSB/SJU, in which a grade of "C" or better was received, and that have a course number 1000 or above*. Note: A minimum of three semester credits is required to complete a CSB/SJU core curriculum requirement, with the exception of fine arts.

At least 45 of the 124 semester credits required for a degree must be earned from CSB/SJU. At least half of the credits required for the major, excluding supporting courses, must be earned from CSB/SJU.

Finally, it should be noted that this guide is designed as one tool to aid in your course selections for transferring to CSB/SJU. Listed below each of the CSB/SJU Core Curriculum requirements (bolded) are the **Normandale Community College** courses that fulfill that specific requirement.

FIRST YEAR SYMPOSIUM

Transfer credits need to be discussed with Academic Advising.

HUMANITIES

A course from two different disciplines with a minimum of three semester credits per course.

COMM: 1106

(Math 1050 and 1060 together will fulfill the core and major requirements for elementary education majors)
(Math 1500 will fulfill proficiency requirement but not the math course requirement)

NATURAL SCIENCES

A course from two different science disciplines with a minimum of three semester credits—all courses must have labs.

BIOL: All courses except 1110, 1125, 1900, 2900

CHEM: All courses except 2058, 2059

ENGR: All courses except 1126

GEOG: 1101

GEOL: 1101, 1102, 1110 w/1111

PHYS: All courses except 1104, 2250

SOCIAL SCIENCES

A minimum of three semester credits is necessary to fulfill requirement.

ANTH: 1125, 1126, 1127, 2250

ECON: 2201, 2202

GEOG: 1102, 1170

POLS: All courses except 1190, 1900, 2900

PSYC: 1100, 1106, 1108, 1109, 1110, 1120, 2210

SOC: 1100, 1102, 1104, 1106, 1115, 1121, 2108, 2110, 2114, 2125

FINE ARTS

A minimum of four semester credits is necessary to fulfill the requirement.

ART: All courses except 2200, 2224

MUSC: All courses

THTR: All courses

FOREIGN LANGUAGES

A student will have fulfilled the foreign language requirement if they have documented proficiency through Intermediate 2100 or have taken courses through Intermediate 2100.

FREN: All courses

JAPN: All courses

SPAN: All courses

GERM: All courses
