

NORTHLAND COMMUNITY COLLEGE

The College of Saint Benedict (CSB) and Saint John's University (SJU) welcome Northland Community College transfer students. All courses from an official transcript will be evaluated to determine which of our Core Curriculum requirements they will fulfill.

Transferable courses are defined as *courses that are similar to a course offered at CSB/SJU, in which a grade of "C" or better was received, and that have a course number 1000 or above*. Note: A minimum of three semester credits is required to complete a CSB/SJU core curriculum requirement, with the exception of fine arts.

At least 45 of the 124 semester credits required for a degree must be earned from CSB/SJU. At least half of the credits required for the major, excluding supporting courses, must be earned from CSB/SJU.

Finally, it should be noted that this guide is designed as one tool to aid in your course selections for transferring to CSB/SJU. Listed below each of the CSB/SJU Core Curriculum requirements (bolded) are the **Northland Community College** courses that fulfill that specific requirement.

FIRST YEAR SYMPOSIUM

Transfer credits need to be discussed with Academic Advising.

HUMANITIES

A course from two different disciplines with a minimum of three semester credits per course.

ENGL: 1126, 2241, 2242, 2248, 2251, 2252

HIST: 1101—2210

HUMN: 1101

PHIL: 1101, 1102, 2240

MATH (one course)

MATH: 1102, 1104, 2203, 2231, 2232, 2233

(Math 1106, 1110, 1113, 1131 will fulfill proficiency requirement but not the math course requirement)

NATURAL SCIENCES

A course from two different science disciplines with a minimum of three semester credits—all courses must have labs.

BIOL: 1111, 1112, 2221, 2252, 2254

CHEM: 1121, 1122, 2205, 2211, 2212, 2221

NSCI: 1103, 1123, 2203

PHYS: All courses except 2211, 2212

SOCIAL SCIENCES

A minimum of three semester credits is necessary to fulfill requirement.

ANTH: 2202

ECON: 1110, 2201, 2202

GEOG: 2242

PLSC: All courses except 1181, 2235

PSYC: 1101

SOCI: All courses except 2215, 2250

SPAN: 1120

FINE ARTS

A minimum of four semester credits is necessary to fulfill the requirement.

ARTS: All courses

JOUR: 1106, 1130

MUSC: All courses

THEA: All courses

FOREIGN LANGUAGES

A student will have fulfilled the foreign language requirement if they have documented proficiency through the intermediate level or have taken courses through Intermediate 2201.

ADDITIONAL COURSES ACCEPTED FOR ELECTIVE CREDIT

These courses may or may not fulfill major requirements. Major departments will determine what requirements may be fulfilled by transfer work.
