

## COTTEY COLLEGE

**T**he College of Saint Benedict (CSB) welcomes Cottey College transfer students. The College of Saint Benedict for women works in a close coordinate relationship with Saint John's University (SJU) for men. All courses from an official transcript will be evaluated to determine which of our Common Curriculum requirements they will fulfill.

Transferable courses are defined as *courses that are similar to a course offered at CSB/SJU, in which a grade of "C" or better was received, and that have a course number 100 or above*. Note: A minimum of three semester credits is required to complete a CSB/SJU common curriculum requirement, with the exception of fine arts.

At least 45 of the 124 semester credits required for a degree must be earned from CSB/SJU. At least half of the credits required for the major, excluding supporting courses, must be earned from CSB/SJU.

Finally, it should be noted that this guide is designed as one tool to aid in your course selections for transferring to CSB/SJU. Listed below each of the CSB/SJU Common Curriculum requirements (bolded) are the **Cottey College** courses that fulfill that specific requirement.

**SOCIAL SCIENCES**

A minimum of three semester credits is necessary to fulfill requirement. Students majoring in a social science cannot use an introductory course to satisfy this requirement.
