

## FOND DU LAC COMMUNITY COLLEGE

**T**he College of Saint Benedict (CSB) and Saint John's University (SJU) welcome Fond Du Lac Community College transfer students. All courses from an official transcript will be evaluated to determine which of our Common Curriculum requirements they will fulfill.

Transferable courses are defined as *courses that are similar to a course offered at CSB/SJU, in which a grade of "C" or better was received, and that have a course number 1000 or above.* Note: A minimum of three semester credits is required to complete a CSB/SJU common curriculum requirement, with the exception of fine arts.

At least 45 of the 124 semester credits required for a degree must be earned from CSB/SJU. At least half of the credits required for the major, excluding supporting courses, must be earned from CSB/SJU.

Finally, it should be noted that this guide is designed as one tool to aid in your course selections for transferring to CSB/SJU. Listed below each of the CSB/SJU Common Curriculum requirements (bolded) are the **Fond Du Lac Community College** courses that fulfill that specific requirement.

### FIRST YEAR SEMINAR

Transfer credits need to be discussed with Academic Advising.

### HUMANITIES

A course from two different disciplines with a minimum of three semester credits.

ENGL: 2010, 2015, 2020, 2035, 2040, 2045

HIST: 1010, 1011, 1030, 1031

JOUR: 1001

PHIL: 2001, 2010, 2020

### MATH (one course)

MATH: 1030, 1040, 1050, 2001, 2002, 2020

### NATURAL SCIENCES

One lab course with a minimum of three semester credits.

BIOL: 1010, 1060, 1101, 1102, 2010, 2020, 2021, 2030, 2031, 2040, 2050, 2060

CHEM: 1001, 1002, 1010, 1011, 2010, 2011, 2060

GEOL: 1001

PHYS: 1001, 1002, 1020

**SOCIAL SCIENCES**

A minimum of three semester credits is necessary to fulfill requirement. Students majoring in a social science cannot use an introductory course to satisfy this requirement.

ECON: 2010, 2020  
POLS: 1010  
PSYC: 2001  
SOC: 1001

**FINE ARTS**

A minimum of three semester credits is necessary to fulfill the requirement.

ART: All courses except 1099  
ENGL: 2025, 2030  
MUSC: All courses except 1099  
THEA: All courses except 1099 or 2090

**FOREIGN LANGUAGES**

A student will have fulfilled the foreign language requirement if he/she has documented proficiency through the intermediate level or has taken courses through the intermediate level.

**ADDITIONAL COURSES ACCEPTED FOR ELECTIVE CREDIT**

These courses may or may not fulfill major requirements. Major departments will determine what requirements may be fulfilled by transfer work.
