MINNESOTA WEST COMMUNITY TECHNICAL COLLEGE(WORTHINGTON)

The College of Saint Benedict (CSB) and Saint John's University (SJU) welcome Minnesota West Community and Technical College transfer students. All courses from an official transcript will be evaluated to determine which of our Core Curriculum requirements they will fulfill.

Transferable courses are defined as *courses that are similar to a course offered at CSB/SJU, in which a grade of "C" or better was received, and that have a course number 1000 or above*. Note: A minimum of three semester credits is required to complete a CSB/SJU core curriculum requirement, with the exception of fine arts.

At least 45 of the 124 semester credits required for a degree must be earned from CSB/SJU. At least half of the credits required for the major, excluding support courses, must be earned from CSB/SJU.

Finally, it should be noted that this guide is designed as one tool to aid in your course selections for transferring to CSB/SJU. Listed below each of the CSB/SJU Core Curriculum requirements (bolded) are the **Minnesota West Community and Technical College** courses that fulfill that specific requirement.

FIRST YEAR SEMINAR

Transfer credits need to be discussed with Academic Advising.

HUMANITIES

A course from two different disciplines with a minimum of three semester credits.

ENGL: 1105, 2201, 2202, 2221, 2222
HIST: 1101, 1102, 1105
PHIL: 1101, 1200

MATH (one course)

MATH: 1121, 1122, 2201, 2203, 2204
(1111, 1113 will fulfill proficiency requirement but not the math course requirement)

NATURAL SCIENCES

One lab course with a minimum of three semester credits.

BIOL: 1100, 1110, 2220, 2230, 2240, 2250, 2260, 2270
CHEM: 1100, 1101, 1102, 1150, 2201, 2202
NSCI: 1100
PHYS: 1100, 1201, 1202, 2121, 2122

SOCIAL SCIENCES

A minimum of three semester credits is necessary to fulfill requirement. Students majoring in a social science cannot use an introductory course to satisfy this requirement.

ECON: 2201, 2202
PSCI: 1101
PSYC: 1101
SOC: 1101

FINE ARTS

A minimum of three semester credits is necessary to fulfill the requirement.

ART: All courses except 1118 & 2235
MUSC: All courses
THTR: 1101, 1105, 1106, 2105, 2106

FOREIGN LANGUAGES

A student will have fulfilled the foreign language requirement if he/she has documented proficiency through the intermediate level or has taken courses through Intermediate 2201.

ADDITIONAL COURSES ACCEPTED FOR ELECTIVE CREDIT

These courses may or may not fulfill major requirements. Major departments will determine what requirements may be fulfilled by transfer work.
