

SAINT PAUL COLLEGE

The College of Saint Benedict (CSB) and Saint John's University (SJU) welcome Saint Paul College transfer students. All courses from an official transcript will be evaluated to determine which of our Common Curriculum requirements they will fulfill.

Transferable courses are defined as *courses that are similar to a course offered at CSB/SJU, in which a grade of "C" or better was received, and that have a course number 100 or above*. Note: A minimum of three semester credits is required to complete a CSB/SJU common curriculum requirement, with the exception of fine arts.

At least 45 of the 124 semester credits required for a degree must be earned from CSB/SJU. At least half of the credits required for the major, excluding supporting courses, must be earned from CSB/SJU.

Finally, it should be noted that this guide is designed as one tool to aid in your course selections for transferring to CSB/SJU. Listed below each of the CSB/SJU Common Curriculum requirements (bolded) are the **Saint Paul College** courses that fulfill that specific requirement.

FIRST YEAR SEMINAR

Transfer credits need to be discussed with Academic Advising.

HUMANITIES

A course from two different disciplines with a minimum of three semester credits per course.

ENGL: 1780, 1790, 2721, 2722, 2730, 2740, 2750, 2760, 2770

HIST: 1730, 1741, 1742, 2740, 1750, 1760, 1761, 1770

HUMA: 1710

PHIL: 1700, 1710, 1720, 1750

SPCH: 1740

MATH (one course)

MATH: 1710, 1740, 2751, 2752

(Math 1411, 1730 and 1760 will fulfill the proficiency requirement but not the math course requirement)

NATURAL SCIENCES

One lab course with a minimum of three semester credits.

BIOL: 1725, 1730, 1740, 1745, 1750, 1780, 2721, 2722

CHEM: 1700, 1711, 1712

NSCI: 1720, 1760

PHYS: 1720, 2700, 2710

SOCIAL SCIENCES

A minimum of three semester credits is necessary to fulfill requirement. Students majoring in a social science cannot use an introductory course to satisfy this requirement.

ECON: 1720, 1730
 POLS: 1720, 1750
 PSYC: 1710
 SOCI: 1710

FINE ARTS

A minimum of three semester credits is necessary to fulfill the requirement.

ARTS: All courses
 HUMA: 1770, 1780, 1790
 MUSC: All courses
 THTR: 1710

Foreign Language

A student will have fulfilled the foreign language requirement if he/she has documented proficiency through the intermediate level or has taken courses through the Intermediate level.

ADDITIONAL COURSES ACCEPTED FOR ELECTIVE CREDIT

These courses may or may not fulfill major requirements. Major departments will determine what requirements may be fulfilled by transfer work.
