

Hibbing Community College

The College of Saint Benedict (CSB) and Saint John's University (SJU) welcome **Hibbing Community College** Transfer Students. All courses from an official transcript will be evaluated to determine which of our Core Curriculum requirements they will fulfill.

Transferable courses are defined as *courses that are similar to a course offered at CSB/SJU, in which a grade of "C" or better was received, and that have a course number 1000 or above.*

At least 45 of the 124 semester credits required for a degree must be earned from CSB/SJU. At least half of the credits required for the major, excluding supporting courses, must be earned from CSB/SJU.

Finally, it should be noted that this guide is designed as one tool to aid in your course selections for transferring to CSB/SJU. Listed below are the CSB/SJU Core Curriculum requirements (bolded) and the **Hibbing Community College** courses that fulfill that specific requirement.

FIRST YEAR SYMPOSIUM

Transfer credits need to be discussed with Academic Advising.

MATH (one course)

MATH: 1050, 1090, 1100, 1200, 2010, 2101, 2111, 2121, 2150, 2211

(Math 1040, 1300, 1500 will fulfill proficiency requirement but not math course.)

NATURAL SCIENCES

A course from two science different science disciplines with a minimum of three semester credits.

ASTR: 1050, 1150

BIOL: 1050, 1120, 1250, 1260, 1510, 1520, 2200

CHEM: 1110, 1120, 1610, 1611, 2710, 2720

ENSC: 1050

GEOL: 1010

NSCI: 1500

PHYS: All courses

HUMANITIES

A course from two science different disciplines with a minimum of three semester credits.

ENGL: 1110, 1130, 1140, 1150, 2110, 2120, 2210, 2220

HIST: 1050, 1060, 1250, 1260, 1400, 2300, 2580

PHIL: 1200, 1250, 1300

SOCIAL SCIENCES

A minimum of 3 semester credits is necessary to fulfill requirement.

ANTH: 101
ECON: 1010, 1030, 1050
GEOG: 1100
POLS: All courses
PSYC: 1200, 1350, 1400, 2100
SOC: 1100, 1200, 1300, 2200, 2300

FINE ARTS

A minimum of 6 semester credits is necessary to fulfill requirement.

ART: All courses
MACO: 1300, 1310, 1450
MCS: 1070
MUSC: All courses
THEA: All courses
ENGL: 1170

FOREIGN LANGUAGES

A student will have fulfilled the foreign language requirement if he/she has documented proficiency through the intermediate level or has taken courses through the Intermediate level.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

All courses except 1380, 1480 and 1800 are accepted to fulfill our non-credit physical education requirement. HLTH 1150 may be used to fulfill the CSB/SJU PE 117 requirement.

*NOTE: The credits do not transfer.

ADDITIONAL COURSES ACCEPTED FOR CREDIT

These courses may or may not fulfill major requirements. Major departments will determine what requirements may be fulfilled by transfer work.
