

# Riverland Community College

**T**he College of Saint Benedict (CSB) and Saint John's University (SJU) welcome **Riverland Community College** (formerly Austin Community College) transfer students. All courses from an official transcript will be evaluated to determine which of our Core Curriculum requirements they will fulfill.

Transferable courses are defined as courses that are similar to a course offered at CSB/SJU, in which a grade of "C" or better was received, and that have a course number 1000 or above.

At least 45 of the 124 semester credits required for a degree must be earned from CSB/SJU. At least half of the credits required for the major, excluding supporting courses, must be earned from CSB/SJU.

Finally, it should be noted that this guide is designed as one tool to aid in your course selections for transferring to CSB/SJU. Listed below each of the CSB/SJU Core Curriculum requirements (bolded) are the **Riverland Community College** courses that fulfill that specific requirement.

## FIRST YEAR SYMPOSIUM

Transfer credits need to be discussed with Academic Advising.

## MATH

MATH: 1050, 1200, 1210, 1220, 1400  
(1110, 1120 will fulfill math proficiency but not math requirement)

## NATURAL SCIENCE

A course from two different science disciplines with a minimum of three semester credits—all courses must have labs.

BIOL: 1010, 1091, 1092, 2021, 2022, 2030

CHEM: 1201, 1202, 2201 w/ 2202, 2203 w/ 2204

PHYS: 1000, 1501, 1502, 2101 w/ 2501, 2102 w/ 2502

## FOREIGN LANGUAGES

A student will have fulfilled the foreign language requirement if he/she has documented proficiency or taken courses through the intermediate level.

FREN: 1101, 1102, and 2101 fulfills our foreign language proficiency requirement.

SPAN: 1001, 1002, and 2001 fulfills our foreign language proficiency requirement.

(Requirement may also be fulfilled through a proficiency exam.)

## **SOCIAL SCIENCES**

A minimum of three semester credits is necessary to fulfill this requirement.

## **FINE ARTS**

A minimum of six semester credits is necessary to fulfill this requirement.

1160, 1161, 1170, 1171, 2123-2128, 2150, 2151,  
2160, 2161, 2170, 2171  
THTR: 1100, 2100, 1001-1002, 2001-2002

## **HUMANITIES**

A course from two different disciplines with a minimum of three semester credits.

ENGL: 1103, 1131, 2231, 2241, 2242, 2251  
HIST: 1001, 1002, 1011, 1012, 1020, 1030  
HUM: 1101, 1102, 2263  
PHIL: 1110

## **PHYSICAL EDUCATION**

All courses except 2250 and 2251. Courses accepted to fulfill our non-credit P.E. requirement. NOTE: The credits do not transfer.

## **ADDITIONAL COURSES ACCEPTED FOR CREDIT**
