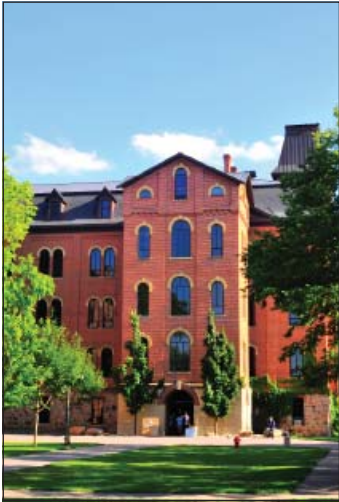


# Discover Possible Majors

- Select and meet with a Faculty Advisor in a department that interests you to create a four-year plan that includes Common Curriculum courses, major requirements, elective courses and experiential learning opportunities (see Discover by Doing). Include this information in your ATLAS Planner.
- Check Banner Web Self-Service for the record of Common Curriculum requirements you have satisfied.
- Build relationships with faculty members and staff through class and individual appointments.
- Apply to major(s) during your sophomore year (contact academic departments for requirements and deadlines).
- Complete “Application for Degree” during the spring semester of your junior year.
