NRSNG 362-01: Health Care Policies, Leadership & Mgmt in Nursing, 4 cr.

In this course the learner will develop knowledge and skills to effectively integrate designer, manager, and coordinator of care roles in community-based and population-focused nursing practice. Contextual factors, such as policy decisions, economics, and social values and norms, which enhance and constrain health related-decisions will be explored.
