Suspected Reporting of Children or Vulnerable Adults (Physical Abuse, Sexual Abuse, or Neglect) All employees and students must report suspected child abuse to CSB/SJU.

- 1. If a student is experiencing an emergency situation that requires immediate assistance, call 911.
- 2. Student is required to report suspicion of neglect/abuse to site supervisor immediately.
- 3. Students Working with Children: Student is required to contact Adia Zeman Theis, a CSB/SJU member of the Child Protection Report Team at (320) 363-5237 or azemantheis@csbsju.edu to report suspected child abuse/neglect within 72 hours of becoming aware of the incident. Adia will assist student in determining next steps. Student may contact Stearns County Human Services at (320) 656-6000, if Adia is unavailable within the 72 hour timeframe; however, student is still required to report incident to Adia as soon as possible. - 4. **Students Working with Vulnerable Adults**: Student should report any suspected abuse or neglect to his/her site supervisor immediately. Please contact Adia as soon as possible to follow proper protocol, in accordance with HIPAA.
