The College of Saint Benedict (CSB) and Saint John's University (SJU) welcome Minnesota State Community and Technical College transfer students. All courses from an official transcript will be evaluated to determine which of our Common Curriculum requirements they will

Transferable courses are defined as *courses that are similar to a course offered at CSB/SJU, in which a grade of "C" or better was received, and that have a course number 1000 or above.* Note: A minimum of three semester credits is required to complete a CSB/SJU common curriculum requirement, with the exception of fine arts.

At least 45 of the 124 semester credits required for a degree must be earned from CSB/SJU. At least half of the credits required for the major, excluding supporting courses, must be earned from CSB/SJU.

Finally, it should be noted that this guide is designed as one tool to aid in your course selections for transferring to CSB/SJU. Listed below each of the CSB/SJU Common Curriculum requirements (bolded) are the **Minnesota State Community and Technical College** courses that fulfill that specific requirement.

FIRST YEAR SEMINAR

Transfer credits need to be discussed with Academic Advising.

HUMANITIES

A course from two different disciplines with a minimum of three semester credits.

HIST: All courses

NATURAL SCIENCES

One lab course with a minimum of three semester credits.

BIOL: 1104, 1107 w/1108, 1111, 1112, 2230, 2232, 2257, 2266

CHEM: 1100, 1101, 1111, 1112, 2224, 2225

PHYS: All courses except 1411, 1412

ZOO: 1122, 2201, 2224

SOCIAL SCIENCES

A minimum of three semester credits is necessary to fulfill requirement. Students majoring in a social science cannot use an introductory course to satisfy this requirement.

PSCI: 1112
PSYC: 1200

FINE ARTS

A minimum of three semester credits is necessary to fulfill the requirement.

ART: All courses except 1135
HUM: 1120, 2210

THEA: All courses

FOREIGN LANGUAGES

A student will have fulfilled the foreign language requirement if he/she has documented proficiency through the intermediate level or has taken courses through Intermediate 2211.

ADDITIONAL COURSES ACCEPTED FOR ELECTIVE CREDIT
