Steps to a successful study abroad application:

1. Begin the search early. Your first year of college is not too early to plan! With careful preparation you can be sure that study abroad becomes an integral part of your college career.
2. Attend the informational group advising sessions *Study Abroad 101*.
3. Gather additional information on your program(s) of choice. Consider speaking with the Faculty Director, Study Abroad Ambassadors or past participants. You can also make an appointment to visit with the Study Abroad Advisor at OEA (Peggy Retka or Joy Hemmesch). Use the OEA website, printed brochures and other resources available.
4. Research study abroad scholarships and other funding options for study abroad. Basic information is available on the OEA and Financial Aid websites. You can also schedule a meeting with the Financial Aid Office.
5. Meet with your Academic Advisor to discuss how study abroad will fit into your four-year plan. You can fulfill many of the core requirements and some major/minor requirements through your semester abroad.
6. Attend a session on *Preparing your Study Abroad Application*.
7. Complete the on-line application. Remember the deadline is January 20, 2009 for the Fall 2009 and Spring 2010 programs.
8. Prepare for your interview with the faculty director. Attend a session on *Study Abroad Interview Preparation*.
9. After acceptance, continue to research your study abroad destination and attend orientation on March 21st, 2009 and other all pre-departure sessions .
