



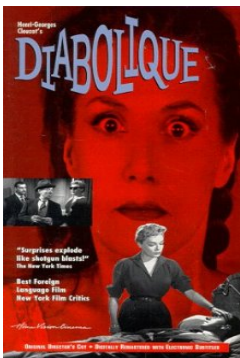
FRENCH FILM SERIES, FALL 2009

Mon. 21 Sept. (Day 6) – **Les Choristes** (97 min.) – Q346 Little Theatre SJU (Christophe Barratier, 2003)

A powerful story of conflict between a harsh, disciplinarian headmaster and a new teacher who seeks to transform his pupils' lives through choral music. The film was nominated for an Academy Award and Golden Globe (best foreign language film); the soundtrack became an international bestseller.



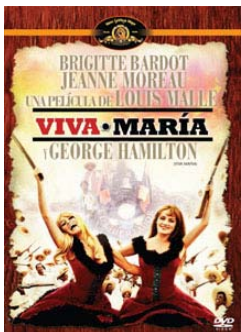
Thu. 29 Oct. (Day 2) – **Diabolique** (116 min.) – AV-1, Alcuin Library SJU (Henri-Georges Clouzot, 1955)

For Halloween, the film that scared the pants off audiences when it came out in 1955. Compared to the blood and violence we see on screen nowadays it seems a rather tame, but the suspense build-up is terrific.



Tue. 17 Nov. (Day 3) – **Entre les murs** (130 min.) – Q364 Little Theatre SJU (Laurent Cantet, 2008)

Winner of the Palme d'Or at the 2008 Cannes Film Festival, master French director Laurent Cantet's THE CLASS is an absorbing journey into a multicultural high school in Paris over the course of a school year.



Wed. 9 Dec. (Day 4) – **Viva Maria!** (117 min.) – AV-1 Alcuin Library SJU (Louis Malle, 1965)

France's most notorious sex kitten and the sultry Jeanne Moreau team up in this madcap send-up of the American western.
