ABOUT THE CAMP – THE SPRING TRAINING BASEBALL SCHOOL OFFERS THE OPPORTUNITY FOR YOUTH PLAYERS TO WORK ON THE SKILLS REQUIRED OF THEM TO PLAY THE GAME OF BASEBALL. A POSITIVE AND SUPPORT FOCUSED ENVIRONMENT ENABLES THE PLAYER TO EXPERIENCE THE TEACHING OF THE GAME OF BASEBALL. STBS IS DIRECTED BY COACHES WHOSE PROFESSION IS COACHING AND TEACHING THE GAME OF BASEBALL.

CAMP OPERATIONS – THE CAMPS OBJECTIVE IS TO CONCENTRATE ON THE BASIC FUNDAMENTALS OF THE GAME OF BASEBALL. THE CAMP FOCUSES ON THE PROPER TECHNIQUE OF THROWING, HITTING, CATCHING, FIELDING GROUND BALLS AND FLY BALLS, BASE RUNNING, AND DEVELOPING A CONSISTENT MENTAL APPROACH TO THE GAME. THE FOCUS WILL BE IN SMALL GROUPS WORKING THE FUNDAMENTALS INTO GAME SITUATIONS. THERE WILL BE AN 8 TO 1 STUDENT TO INSTRUCTOR RATIO, WHICH WILL PROVIDE A GREAT LEARNING ATMOSPHERE AS WELL AS ENABLE PLENTY OF REPETITION OF PRESCRIBED DRILLS. GROUPS WILL BE MADE UP ACCORDING TO AGE. THE CAMPER WILL BE WORKING ON HITTING SKILLS AND DRILLS ABOUT 50% OF THE TIME. THROWING AND POSITION TRAINING WILL BE INCORPORATED WITH OTHER BASEBALL FUNDAMENTALS.

ABOUT THE AGE GROUPS- THE SCHOOL IS OPEN TO STUDENTS AGES 9 – 18 FOR INSTRUCTION AND DEVELOPMENT. ENROLLEMNT FOR THE CAMP IS LIMITED. CAMPERS WILL BE GROUPED WITH OTHER CAMPERS WITHIN THEIR SAME AGE LEVEL.

ABOUT THE FACILITY- THE MCNEELY SPECTRUM IS A 63,000 SQUARE FOOT BUILDING WITH SPACIOUS CEILING. BASEBALL HAS TWO FULL INFIELDS, TWO PERMANENT 70' x 15' BATTING CAGES, PORTABLE PITCHING MOUNDS, NUMEROUS PORTABLE HITTING NETS, AND MANY OTHER AMENITIES THAT MAKE THIS A TRUE SPRING TRAINING ATMOSPHERE. HITTING TEES, RADAR GUN, PITCHING MACHINES, SPECIALIZED INSTRUCTIONAL AIDS AND VCR EQUIPMENT ARE ALL AVAILABLE WITH THE CAMP EXPERIENCE. THE SPACE AND EQUIPMENT MAKE IT POSSIBLE FOR MANY STATIONS TO BE CONDUCTED AT THE SAME TIME. THIS IS ONE OF THE BEST INDOOR BASEBALL FACILITIES AVAILABLE IN CENTRAL MINNESOTA AND SECOND TO NONE IN THE STATE.

WHAT TO BRING – STUDENTS SHOULD BRING THEIR OWN BAT, GLOVE, BASEBALL CAP, PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT, AND ANY LUNCH OR SNACK ITEMS THEY CHOOSE TO HAVE. BALL, HELMETS, DRINK DURING BREAK, AND STBS T-SHIRTS WILL BE PROVIDED. ***STUDENTS SHOULD LABEL ALL PERSONAL EQUIPMENT FOR EASY IDENTIFICATION.***

JERRY BEGINS HIS 31ST SEASON OF COLLEGE COACHING. ALL 31 HAVE BEEN AT SJU. A PAST MIAC COACH OF THE YEAR, HAUGEN HAS GUIDED THE JOHNNIES TO TWO CONFERENCE TITLES. ONE OF THE REGION'S TOP PROGRAMS, SJU HAS ENJOYED NATIONAL RANKINGS ON MANY OCCASIONS (26TH IN 2005) AND HAS PLAYED IN THE 1994 AND 1998 MIDWEST REGIONAL TOURNAMENT. IN 2003 SJU PLAYED FOR THE CHAMPIONSHIP OF THE MIAC TOURNAMENT. SINCE 1978 MANY ALL MIAC, ALL REGIONAL, ACADEMIC ALL REGIONAL AND ACADEMIC ALL AMERICANS HAVE PLAYED FOR COACH HAUGEN. THE 1997 SEASON BROUGHT SJU A FIRST TEAM ALL AMERICAN. SJU HAD THE NATIONAL BATTING CHAMPION IN 1993 AND 1997. JERRY IS A CHAIRMAN OF THE ABCA RESEARCH COMMITTEE, CO-CHAIR OF THE ABCA CLINIC COMMITTEE AND REGIONAL CHAIR OF THE ALL AMERICAN COMMITTEE. HE CURRENTLY RANKS AS THE "DEAN" OF MIAC COACHES WITH 31 SEASONS OF CONFERENCE PLAY. HE HAS SERVED AS THE CONFERENCES CHAIR. HE HAS MORE WINS THAN ANY COACH IN SJU HISTORY WITH 568. NUMBER 500 COMING AT SJU VS UW-SUPERIOR. COACH HAUGEN HAS BEEN INVOLVED WITH YOUTH CLINICS FOR OVER 30 YEARS. A STANDOUT TWO SPORT ATHLETE DURING HIS COLLEGE YEARS, HE WAS VOTED OUTSTANDING SENIOR ATHLETE AT SJU, ALONG WITH MANY OTHER POST SEASON AWARDS. HE RESIDES IN ST. CLOUD WITH HIS WIFE JOANNE, AN AREA SCHOOL TEACHER, AND HAS FOUR CHILDREN.

MIKE CARR -CO-DIRECTOR. MIKE IS IN HIS 17TH SEASON AS AN ASSISTANT AT SJU. BEFORE SJU HE WAS THE HEAD BASEBALL COACH AT ST. CLOUD APOLLO HS WHERE HE WON A SATE CHAMPIONSHIP IN 1985. HE ALSO GUIDED THE WAITE PARK LEGION TEAM TO A STATE CHAMPIONSHIP. MIKE WAS A STANDOUT TWO SPORT ATHLETE AT SJU AND IS AN APOLLO HS HALL OF FAME INDUCTEE. MIKE HAS HIS MASTERS IN MATHEMATICS ALONG WITH A MASTERS IN ADMINISTRATION. AFTER TEACHING MATH FOR SEVERAL YEARS HE IS CURRENTLY IN THE POSITION OF ASSISTANT PRINCIPAL AT SARTELL HS. MIKE RESIDES IN ST. CLOUD WITH HIS WIFE SUE AND THREE CHILDREN.
