

## ANOKA-RAMSEY COMMUNITY COLLEGE

**T**he College of Saint Benedict (CSB) and Saint John's University (SJU) welcome Anoka-Ramsey Community College transfer students. All courses from an official transcript will be evaluated to determine which of our Common Curriculum requirements they will fulfill.

Transferable courses are defined as *courses that are similar to a course offered at CSB/SJU, in which a grade of "C" or better was received, and that have a course number 1000 or above*. Note: A minimum of three semester credits is required to complete a CSB/SJU common curriculum requirement, with the exception of fine arts.

At least 45 of the 124 semester credits required for a degree must be earned from CSB/SJU. At least half of the credits required for the major, excluding supporting courses, must be earned from CSB/SJU.

Finally, it should be noted that this guide is designed as one tool to aid in your course selections for transferring to CSB/SJU. Listed below each of the CSB/SJU Common Curriculum requirements (bolded) are the **Anoka-Ramsey Community College** courses that fulfill that specific requirement.

### FIRST YEAR SEMINAR

Transfer credits need to be discussed with Academic Advising.

### HUMANITIES

A course from two different disciplines with a minimum of three semester credits per course.

ENGL: All courses except 1102, 1104, 1121, 2241, 2251, 2261, 2271, 2281, 2299

HIST: 1101—2282

HUM: 1141, 1151, 1161, 2231, 2232, 2233, 2234, 2241, 2251, 2261, 2271

PHIL: 1101, 1110, 1120

WOST: 2242

### MATH (one course)

MATH: All courses will be reviewed individually to verify if they will meet our math requirement.

### NATURAL SCIENCES

One lab course with a minimum of three semester credits.

BIOL: All courses except 1100, 1102, 1104, 1108, 1110, 1140, 1171, 2202, 2206, 2208, 2209, 2229, 2299, (BIOL 1103 must be taken with the lab), 2230

CHEM: All courses except 1020, 1050, 2299

NATS: 1003, 1005

PHYS: All courses except 1007, 2299

**SOCIAL SCIENCES**

A minimum of three semester credits is necessary to fulfill requirement. Students majoring in a social science cannot use an introductory course to satisfy this requirement.

**FINE ARTS**

A minimum of three semester credits is necessary to fulfill the requirement.

**FOREIGN LANGUAGES**

A student will have fulfilled the foreign language requirement if he/she has documented proficiency through the intermediate level or has taken courses through the Intermediate 2201.

These courses may or may not fulfill major requirements. Major departments will determine what requirements may be fulfilled by transfer work.
