

Tips for a Successful Bennie Conversations Interview

Prepare for the interview.

 You do not need to ask all of the questions, so pick the questions you feel will best capture the story.

Silence is OK.

• Let your interviewee(s) think about their answer. Do not try to fill the silence.

LISTEN to your interviewee(s).

• Read between the lines. What is unspoken?

Ask probing questions.

- You have a list of questions, but it is important to dig deeper and probe by asking follow-up questions.
- Ask questions that begin with "how" or "why."

Recognize their heroism AND call it out.

Take a break.

• The interviewee(s) may have "question fatigue." If she is reaching a wall, not making eye contact, moving, etc. it may be time to take a break.

Thank her for sharing her story with you.
