 → Fall-only courses: ACFN 315, ACFN 335 (2cr), ACFN 340, ACFN 353
 → Spring-only courses: ACFN 318, ACFN 330 (2cr), ACFN 331, ACFN 344 (2cr)
 → ACFN 330 and ACFN 344 are offered in alternating spring semesters (every other year)
 → Truth focus course is automatic in this concentration
 → Movement encounter course is automatic in this concentration
