Semester-long Study Abroad Programs: Spend a semester off campus on a signature CSBSJU program.

Fall: Austria, Chile, China, France, Greco-Roman, England- London, Ireland-Galway, Japan, and Roman-Greco

Spring: Australia,, England- London, Germany, Guatemala, Ireland-Cork, Ireland- Dublin, Northern Ireland, South Africa, and Spain

In general, most study abroad programs at CSB/SJU allow you to meet Common curriculum requirements and earn some elective credits towards your overall graduation requirement. Some programs may offer the opportunity to take courses towards your major or minor. The language-focused programs are particularly suited towards earning a degree in that language or working towards your Foreign Language Proficiency. In addition, the area studies majors/minors can be enhanced through a study abroad to that region of the world.

Be sure to discuss your plans to study abroad with your Academic or Faculty Advisor. It is crucial to plan early and build study abroad into your 4-year plan. It is our goal to make study abroad a part of your degree at CSB/SJU. It should not be an extra semester or a semester off.
