## **Global Travel and Health Assessment for Student Travel**

*The U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) Global Health Advisories*

The [U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention](#) has four levels for evaluating the risk of COVID-19 in each country. The level is listed above by level.

Level 4: COVID-19 Very High Level 3: COVID-19 High Level 2: COVID-19 Moderate Level 1: COVID-19 Low

*U.S. State Department (USDOS) Travel Advisories*

The [U.S. Department of State advises all U.S. citizens](#) to understand the impact of COVID-19 before travel abroad. The USDOS has [country-specific travel advisories](#) that evaluates many risk factors.

Level 2: Exercise Increased Caution Level 3: Reconsider Travel

Level 4: Do Not Travel

*U.S. Citizens Allowed Entry?*

Due to the number of COVID-19 cases in the U.S., numerous countries are not allowing U.S. citizens to enter the country.

Red = Entry not allowed

Green = Entry is allowed

*Entry Allowed with Student Visa?*

Some countries have stated that students can enter if they obtain a student visa.

Red = Entry is not allowed with student visa

Green = Entry allowed with student/entrance visa

Gray = Visa not required for program

### *Are Visas Being Issued?*

While students may technically be able to enter on a student visa, foreign consulates in the U.S. must be open and in operation to issue visas.

Red = Student visas are not being issued

Yellow = Student visa issuance is on hold or consulate operation cannot be confirmed

Green = Student visas are being issued in a timely manner

Gray = Visa not required for program

### *Quarantine/Arrival Requirements?*

Most countries have quarantine requirements for U.S. citizens upon entry to the country and require proof of a negative COVID-19 test upon arrival.

Red = Quarantine is not at partner site program location; Quarantine time exceeds 25% of program duration; No confirmed food and staff resources available to students

Yellow = Quarantine at partner site program location; Confirmed food service and staff support available to students during quarantine; Students may be required to show proof of negative COVID test upon arrival

Green = No quarantine or proof of COVID-19 test required

### *In-country travel/curfew restrictions?*

Due to COVID-19, many locations have some level of travel restriction. These restrictions might be required by the local government or our program partner.

Red = Program location under “stay-at-home” order; Curfews in place; Travel prohibited outside program location

Yellow = Restrictions to travel outside city or within host country; Modifications to daily travel in city or within country (i.e. public transportation restrictions)

Green = No travel restrictions imposed in-country

### *COVID Testing Availability*

As of [January 26, 2021](#), the U.S. requires all air passengers (including U.S. citizens) arriving/returning to the U.S. to get tested no more than 3 days (72 hours) before their return flight to the U.S. As such, returning students must be able to secure a timely COVID-19 test in their program country.

Red = COVID-19 testing is not readily available

Yellow = COVID-19 testing is available, but the reporting time for test results is too long (greater than 72 hours) or timing of test results cannot be confirmed

Green = COVID-19 testing is readily available to U.S. citizens and results are reported within 72 hours
