

Community Expectations for CSB|SJU Residents

March 18 – April 13, 2020

The COVID-19 pandemic poses an unprecedented threat to public health on campus, and around the world. With CSB|SJU taking the extraordinary measures to suspend on-campus classes and activities through April 13, our campuses must take steps to ensure the continued health and safety of our community members.

New policies and expectations have been developed to protect community members, just as new directives and policies have been developed nationwide, in order to “flatten the curve”, or slow the rate of infection, exposure, and impact of the virus. As this situation continues to develop, CSB|SJU administration reserves the right to modify these expectations.

All students who have received approval to remain on campus during online classes, through April 13th, must agree and adhere to the following guidelines.

Students who fail to comply with these expectations or are responsible for any violation of campus policy may have their approval to remain on campus revoked.

Amended Guest, Social Event & Behavior Policies

- Residents will not host off-campus visitors (this includes CSB|SJU students not approved to stay on campus) in campus residence halls, apartments, and houses.
- Residents will not allow or provide access into campus residential spaces. Access to all residential spaces is limited during this time, and allowing unauthorized entry is not permitted.
- Residents approved to stay on campus will only be permitted access to their specific residence hall or building.
- Cross-campus visitation is suspended through April 13th: CSB students will not be allowed on the SJU campus, and SJU students will not be allowed on the CSB campus.
- Absolutely no parties or social gatherings will be permitted on either campus.
- Students are expected to practice social distancing according to CDC guidelines while interacting with other campus community members, including leaving 6 feet of space between individuals whenever possible.
- Students will avoid places on and off campus that increase risk of exposure to themselves and the campus community.

Community Prevention & Safety Strategies

- Students will:
 - limit face-to-face interactions with others on campus (stay in your room/apartment rather than using lounge space; maintain adequate distance between yourself and others in residential areas, dining facilities, etc.; not host people in your room/apartment);
 - limit off-campus interactions as much as possible (remain on campus; minimize contact with other people in grocery stores/pharmacies; utilize pick-up, take-out, or delivery services, etc.)
 - wash hands frequently with soap and water (minimum 20 seconds), and/or use hand sanitizer with 60% alcohol content;
 - avoid touching their faces with unwashed hands;
 - practice social distancing techniques at all times, in all locations;
 - clean/disinfect their frequently touched surfaces regularly.
- If a student shows signs of illness or come into contact with anyone known to have the virus, they should:
 - notify CSB|SJU Residence Life staff of their symptoms;
 - seek medical attention;
 - initiate self-quarantine procedures by remaining in their assigned housing unless otherwise directed, further eliminating contact with others, and maintaining healthy habits as directed by a health care professional.

Zero Tolerance for Discrimination

While it is important to take precautions to ensure the health and safety of our community members, it is also important to be informed on the facts of COVID-19, and to reduce any associated fear or stigmas toward affected communities or individuals. CSB|SJU will not tolerate acts of discrimination or harassment toward any community member whose home country/area is impacted by COVID-19, or who is completing a self-quarantine or self-isolation period.
