Assignment Type:

Video project

Project Description/Finished Artifact:

Over the course of the semester, you will identify your interview subject, do background research and develop interview questions, conduct the interview, and edit the interview into a 3–5-minute segment that communicates one aspect of that individual’s experience with war.

Information Literacy or Research Description:

- Annotated bibliography of two substantial sources on the general conflict/timeframe that you plan to use to prepare for the interview (10+ pages or 1 hour video). An annotated bibliography includes full citation for the source (not just a hyperlink) and a short paragraph that summarizes the article and explains how the source will inform the project. Do not cut and paste the abstract for your annotation – that is plagiarism and will be reported to the Academic Dean. Use Chicago (notes and bibliography) style for your citations – more information can be found here: http://www.chicagomanualofstyle.org/tools_citationguide/citation-guide-1.html
- Complete treatment plan, draft five interview questions and complete an annotated bibliography of three sources on your conflict/timeframe (in addition to the two sources in the proposal) - You will meet with the professor and a representative of the library and/or iTech time prior to conducting your interview to discuss the treatment plan. You can also solicit help at this time to identify downloaded video clips from the Vanderbilt TV News Archive (<https://tvnews.vanderbilt.edu>) that may provide useful content for your interview. This treatment plan must be submitted no later than October 2 (although it may be submitted earlier if interview schedule requires).
