Assignment Type:

Digital Exhibit / Digital Humanities

Project Description/Finished Artifact:

The course focuses mainly on postcolonial responses to colonial “fictions.” One of the texts is a late 19th-century book of alphabets for “baby patriots,” which teaches the letters while also proclaiming the might of the British Empire. Each student will create a StoryMap account and “write back” to this book with an updated, postcolonial version, resulting in a digital exhibit of images and verse.
