

## The Sister Margretta Nathe Scholarship for German

The German Department of the College of St. Benedict and St. John's University cordially invites you to apply for the Sister Margretta Nathe Scholarship. The scholarship has been established to support the study of German at the College of St. Benedict. Eligibility for the scholarship is limited to students of the College of St. Benedict who have been admitted to a major in German and who will be juniors or seniors in the fall. The scholarship will be awarded according to the following criteria, in order of importance:

- Academic distinction, particularly in German
- Financial need, as determined by standard procedures of the college
- Commitment to the teaching of German, to graduate studies, or to other professional activity within the field of German (to be used as tie-breaker).

Amounts vary from year to year.

Please apply to the S. Margretta Nathe Scholarship Committee as follows:

1. Submit a current transcript of studies.
2. Draft a one-page curriculum vitae, including German-related activities and experiences (in English)
3. Write a formal letter of application describing present involvement in German-Austrian-Swiss study and activities as well as future aspirations, goals, and commitments (300 words, in German).

Deadline for submitting completed applications will be announced. NOTE: CSB applicants to the Otmar Drekonja Scholarship may also apply to the Nathe Scholarship. Recipients are notified in early April.
