Notes: All 3-credit UNDA courses listed above count for only 3 credits toward a CSB/SJU Psychology major or minor.

If a UNDA course fulfills a Group 1 requirement for a CSB/SJU major, you need to make sure you end up with a total of 44 psychology credits, but it is acceptable to have only 11 credits from the Group 1 courses.

Some courses above indicate a specific equivalence to a CSB|SJU course. If you choose this course at UNDA, you may not also take the equivalent at CSB|SJU.

Any courses which appear on this list can be considered pre-approved for a psychology major or minor. Students **DO NOT need to obtain a signature** from Department Chair, Rodger Narloch, on their *Pre-Approval Form for Classes Taken at a Foreign University as part of a CSB|SJU Sponsored Study Abroad Program*.

GRADE EQUIVALENCIES FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF NOTRE DAME AUSTRALIA AND THE COLLEGE OF SAINT BENEDICT AND SAINT JOHN'S UNIVERSITY

NOTRE DAME AUSTRALIA GRADE = CSB/SJU GRADE

78% or above:	A
70-77%:	AB
65-69%:	B
60-64%:	BC
50-59%:	C
50% or below:	F

Notes: S/U GRADING -- Students are only permitted one S/U grade per semester and letter grades are required for any course for your major unless it is only offered for S/U grading. If you wish S/U grading for a course, you must report this information including the title of the course to your program director. S/U grading must be requested and approved before final exams begin.

ADD/DROP -- Students wishing to drop or drop/add a course at UNDA after the start of the program must receive approval from the Program Director and the International Office at UNDA.

GRADE CHANGES -- No grade can be changed without a written request for a grade change from the instructor of the course. Students must follow any UNDA policy for requesting a grade change.

COURSE NUMBER EQUIVALENCIES ARE AS FOLLOWS:

- a 100 level UNDA course is equivalent to a 200 level CSB/SJU course;
- a 200 level UNDA course is equivalent to a 300 level at CSB/SJU;
- a 300 level UNDA course is equivalent to an upper division major requirement course at CSB/SJU.

COURSE CREDIT EQUIVALENCIES ARE AS FOLLOWS:

A 25 credit course at UNDA is equivalent to 3 CSB|SJU credits. The course will be awarded 3 credits at CSB|SJU. If the course fulfills a particular Common Curriculum requirement (i.e. Fine Arts, Humanities, etc.), it will fulfill the full requirement towards the Common Curriculum, but will only be awarded 3 credits towards overall graduation requirements.
