How does Dan use color in this painting to show that it was painted in the evening?



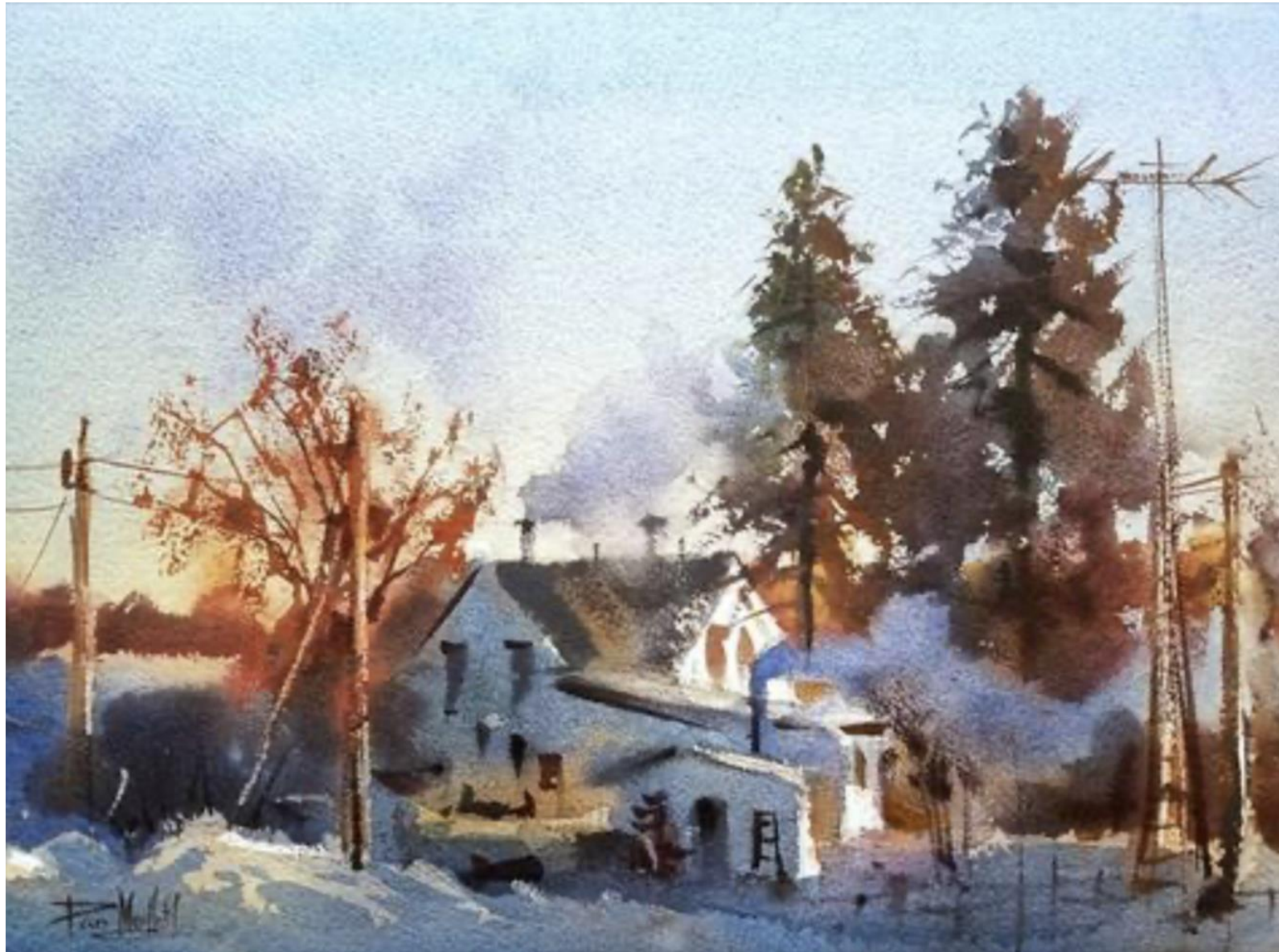
