Most classes are scheduled to meet on either odd days (1-3-5) of the cycle, or on even days (2-4-6). As a result, your classes generally meet every other day. Most likely, you will be registered for four 4-credit classes. Classes (with occasional exceptions--such as Art studios) generally meet for 70 minutes. A 30 minute break between the ending and beginning of periods allows you to easily schedule back-to-back classes, even on both campuses!
