ABSTRACT: Collection includes the book *Treading Along Angel Paths: The Story of Lieutenant Hubert M. Miller (1918-1943)* by a cousin to Hub Miller, Robert G. Ruetz (pronounced “Ritz”), two files of supporting documentation used in the preparation of the book, and correspondence related to its acquisition.

ARRANGEMENT: The files are organized in the order in which they were received.

ACCESS RESTRICTIONS: There are no access restrictions on the materials, and the collection is open to all members of the public.

BIOGRAPHICAL NOTES:

Hubert M. (“Hub”) Miller, Racine, Wisconsin, was a student at SJU for the 1940-1941 academic year. He was drafted into WWII, where he was killed in action. As a student, Miller was on an intramural basketball team, a writer for “The Record,” a tennis player, and acted in two drama productions. He was a lieutenant in the United States Air Force and died on a mission in Sardinia, Italy.
