2022 Summer Student Employment Incentives

What: Free On-Campus Summer Housing OR \$1,000 Bonus at End of Summer

Who: CSB/SJU Students who work an average of at least 35 hours per week for at least 13 weeks between May 8 and August 27 in one of the following departments:

- CSB Custodial
- CSB Events & Catering
- CSB Grounds
- CSB Maintenance
- CSB Security
- IT Services
- SJU Custodial
- SJU Events & Conferences
- SJU Dining Services
- SJU Grounds
- SJU Life Safety
- SJU Paint Shop
- SJU Recreation Lifeguards

Details:

- Students who work in these departments will be able to choose which incentive they prefer. The Student Employment Office will connect with students in these areas in early summer.
- -There is limited on-campus summer housing available at CSB/SJU. Students will need to apply to live on campus through the appropriate Residential Life Office. The preferred deadline to apply for summer housing is April 25th.
- -Both the Free On-Campus Summer Housing and \$1,000 Bonus options are considered taxable income and will be included in student payroll. Details about how this will be applied will be shared in early summer when students choose their preference.
- -CSB/SJU students is defined as a student enrolled for classes at CSB/SJU for Fall 2022, or students who graduated from CSB/SJU in May 2022.
- -If students are unable to work an average of at least 35 hours per week in one of the qualifying departments, they could work part-time in two of the qualifying departments to meet the 35 hour per week requirement. For example, a student could work an average of 15 hours per week in catering and 20 hours per week in custodial for an overall average of at least 35 hours per week.
